CARLI Digitization: Publications of Chicago Religious Congregations

1. Description of material to be digitized.

We propose digitizing publications of religious congregations in Chicago. These include short histories, congregational directories, and anniversary commemorations. Typically printed in small runs, they are not widely held; in a number of cases, the Newberry Library holding is the only WorldCat record for the item.

2. How does the proposal address the theme “Illinois Culture and Heritage” ?

These early church publications are of interest to a variety of historical researchers. They detail the development of Chicago’s religious institutions. For example, *History of Kehillath Anshe Maarabh* (1897) describes the establishment and growth of Chicago’s first synagogue. They document a variety of ethnic communities in Illinois; the selections include German, Swedish and French congregations. All of the publications contain biographical information of interest to genealogists and local historians.
