Voyager System

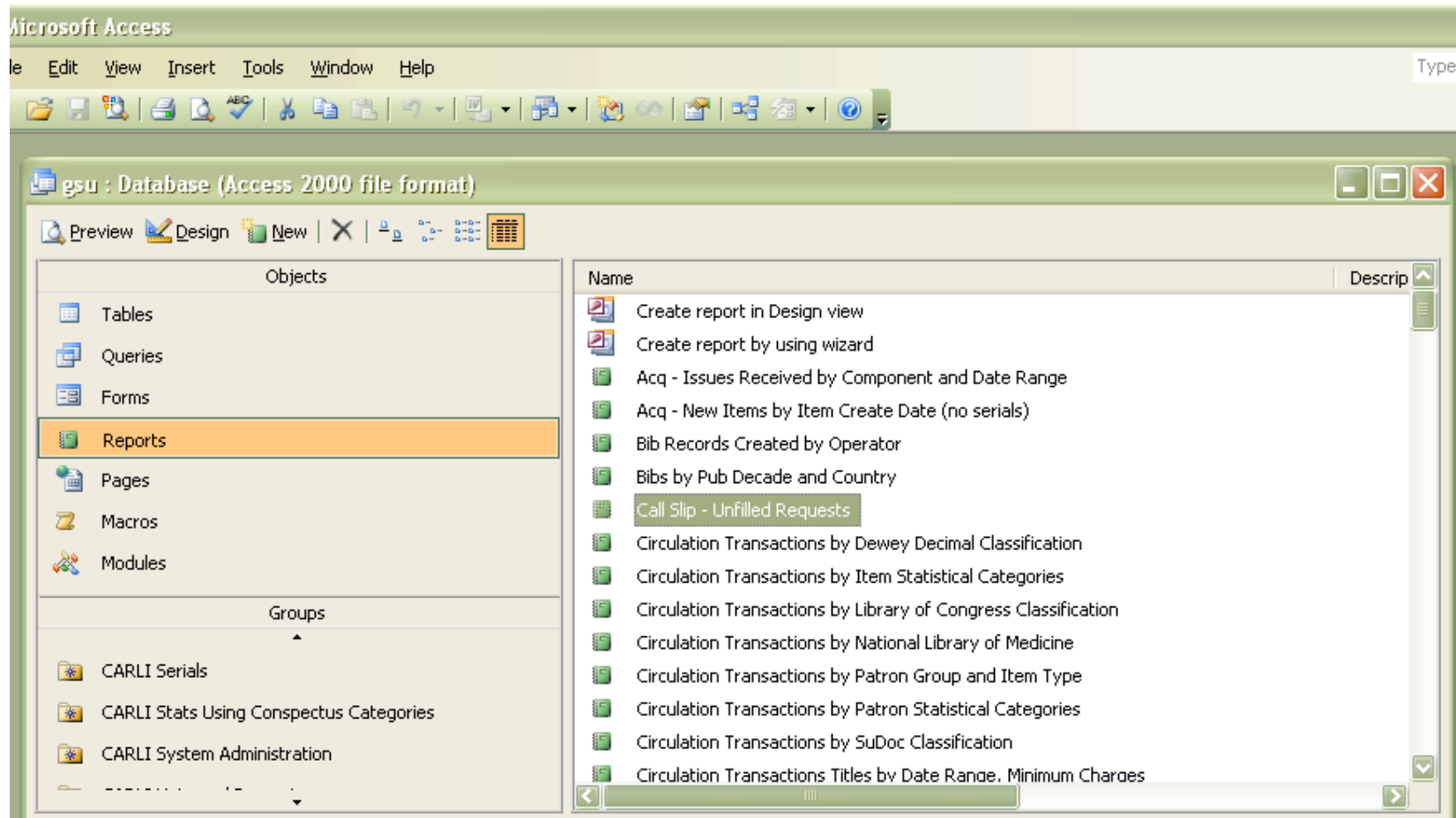

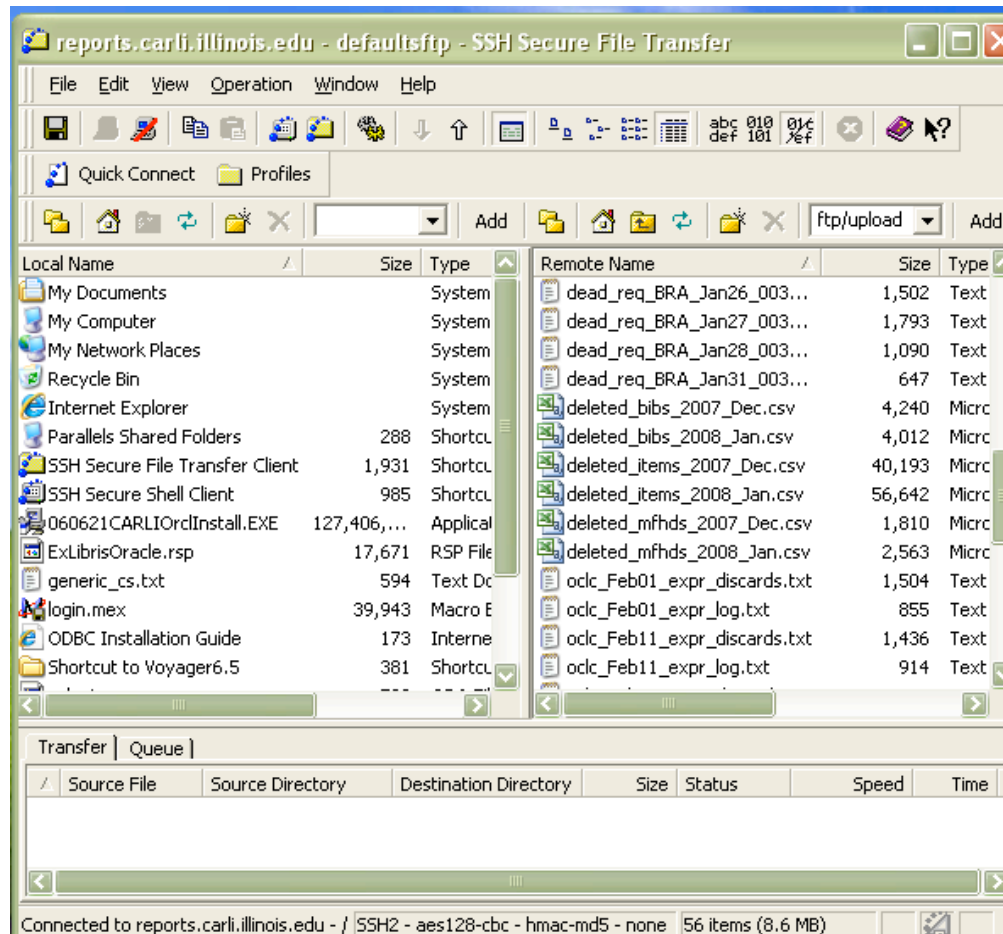
