- The title *Defining Females: The Nature of Women in Society* interests me. What else is in the training database that might be similar to it?
- What does the catalog say comes before "ML1" in the training database's shelf list?

- How many serials in the training database have the word "history" in the title?
- How many scores in any of the Romance Languages (French, Italian, Portuguese or Spanish) are represented in the training database?
