E-books for who?

- Disciplines whose scholarship is primarily article based
- History of using online materials
- Monographs that are not consumed as a whole
- Issues with sustained reading and current platforms
- Endnotes are difficult to use in current platforms



Why supo?

- Default purchase model from aggregators – firm, approval, and PDA is SUPO
- Philosophy of available unless in use
- Already loosing purchasing power

YBP - Social Sciences 1 profile

- Print approval
- Slip notifications (print/ebooks) – firm order
- E-book approval
- E-book automatic PDA records per profile
- E-book manual selections for PDA
- E-book preferred for Bus/Econ
- E-book preferred order – publisher, aggregator
- E-book approval/DDA – first aggregator to load in GOBI
