The closest parking structure is the **Ellis Avenue Parking Garage**, **5505 S. Ellis Ave**. The garage is between S. Cottage Grove Ave. on the west and University Ave. on the east, between 55th Street and 56th Street with garage entrances on both Ellis and Greenwood Avenues. I recommend you use the Ellis Ave. entrance due to construction near the other entrance. Take a ticket at the gate as you enter. You will need the ticket to exit.

Walking to the Library

The garage is behind or one block north of the Mansueto Library and the Regenstein Library (see campus map). Entrance to the Mansueto Library is through the Regenstein Library. From the garage, walk south on Ellis Avenue, past the Henry Moore sculpture and past the Mansueto Library. Turn left on 57th Street to the front of Regenstein.

<u>Arrival</u>

When you arrive at Regenstein, let staff at entrance control know you are here for the CARLI Preservation Open House and they will direct you to Room A11. Turn left just past entry control, proceed to the main staircase and go down one flight. Follow signs to Rm. A-11. Bathrooms are located on the 1st floor and at the bottom of the stairs to the right on the A-Level.

The morning will include tours of the Preservation Department Binding & Shelf Preparation in the Regenstein, and the Digitization and Conservation Labs and the Automated Storage and Retrieval System in the Mansueto Library.
