At her institution, they only mediate requests over a certain amount of money. When they get mediated requests, she sees if the item is in I-Share for ILL. If it is not, she then checks OCLC to see if available there; they use Tipasa to request. If she feels it is something that would be valuable for their collection, then she checks Amazon to see the print price. The DDA would charge much more, so she first tries to contact the patron and ask if okay with print and then purchase. If they only want DDA, then it depends on the price and the value of the item for their collection. They also have short term loans.
