The Early Years

- Provider-specific records
- Vendor-supplied records
- Electronic reproduction
- Form of item (electronic)



Provider-Neutral Records

- Provider-Neutral E-Monograph MARC Record Guide (2009, revised 2011)
- "To develop a provider-neutral cataloging model for a single bibliographic record that could be used for all the iterations of an online monograph. This is to include records for resources that, in the past, have been cataloged variously as reproductions or electronic editions."

Challenges

- Control
 - Title lists
 - Checklist of growing e-book collections
 - OCLC record sets
 - Provider-specific notes
- Updates to e-book collections



More Challenges

- No single workflow
- Increasing number of providers and collections
- Volume of records
 - Batch editing
 - Batch loading



Even More Challenges

- Record availability
- Record quality
 - Vendor-supplied metadata
 - Merged records
- Overlapping coverage



Still More Challenges

- Ongoing record maintenance
 - URL updates
 - Record enhancements
- User expectations
