To be considered for appointment this year, you must fill out the online form, even if you have previously submitted a form or if you are a current committee member whose term is expiring and who wishes to be considered again. CARLI seeks to include as many individuals and institutions as possible in committee service, so reappointments are not routinely made.

CARLI is making every effort to conduct the majority of committee business using web conferencing technologies or via conference calls. However, committee service may require time and/or travel expenses for one or more in-person meetings each year. Anyone volunteering to serve on a CARLI committee, users' group, or team should seek appropriate administrative approval before volunteering.

Only library faculty and staff from I-Share participants may be selected to serve on I-Share committees.

The Executive Director, in consultation with the Executive Committee of the CARLI Board of Directors will make appointments no later than June 10, 2011. All new committee members will officially begin work on July 1, 2011.
