VOYAGER WEB REPORTS

- Web-based Voyager reporting tool built by CARLI staff
- Allows you to run a growing set (100+) of CARLI's Voyager reports without installing an ODBC client or MS Access, or learning to write queries

VUFIND

- CARLI has been running our own modified version of the open source VuFind code for almost 10 years
- We have been working to get back to the standard version to take advantage of the broader community's development
- VuFind will continue to be CARLI's default interface to the I-Share Next catalog
- I-Share libraries can make the new VuFind available to their users now
- Libraries must move off the current version of VuFind by the time we launch I-Share Next
- See the **handout in your packet** for more information on the new VuFind!

I-SHARE NEXT

- Selected product will ultimately replace all Voyager staff components and SFX
- New VuFind will be the default public interface; we are not planning to buy a discovery service/public catalog interface
- Chosen product will better support electronic library collections; leverage consortial setup
- RFP still under review by State Purchasing Officer
- Anticipate a 2+ year process from RFP release through full implementation

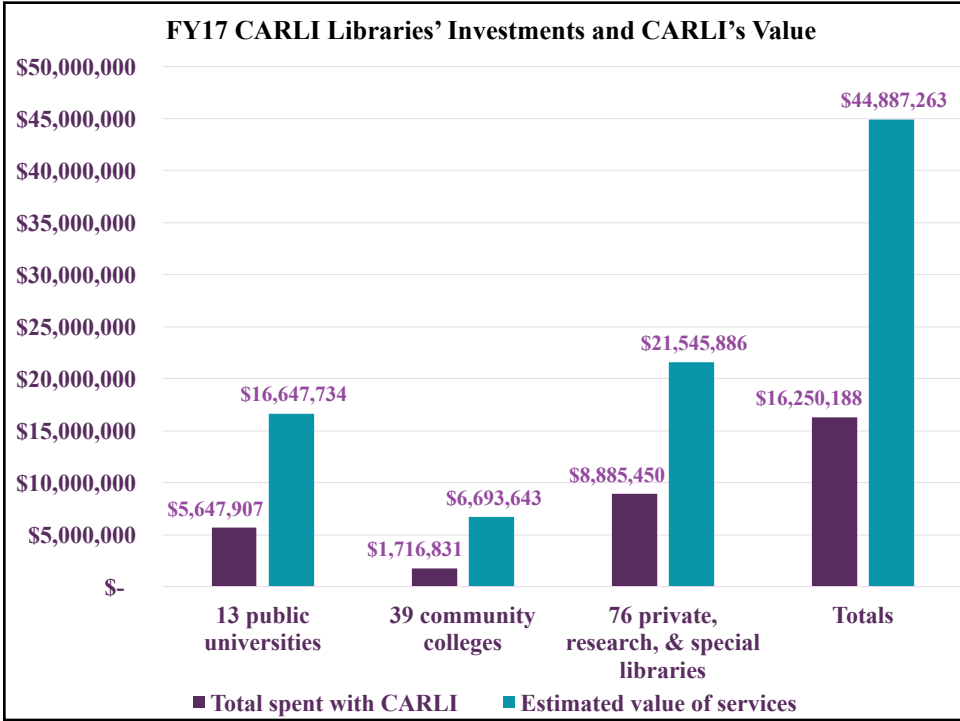

- **FY2018**
 - -12.6% from FY2015 level
 - In real dollars=decrease of about \$525,156 (12.6%)
 - Careful planning during FY15, 16, 17, 18
- **Budget Contingency Task Force, Board of Directors, Finance Committee**
 - Why a Strategic Priority is “ensure stable funding...”
- **CARLI plans ahead (see website for FY19 fees)**
 - Member fees set through FY2019; fees for FY20 soon
 - I-Share fees set through FY2019; fees for FY20 soon

CARLI REVENUE SOURCES FY18

- University of Illinois: \$3.8M
- Membership fees: \$415K
- I-Share assessments: \$1.5M

- Pass-through:
 - Subscriptions to databases: \$17M
 - ILDS grant from the Illinois State Library: \$640K

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Straight pass-through cost from vendor to library • No surcharge applied to the cost • Why advantageous? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Substantial bargaining power of 128 libraries • Centrally negotiated and managed license agreements • Single consolidated invoice for multiple subscriptions • Multi-year agreements, which give libraries greater cost predictability • Discounts of at least 10% (usually much greater) • Capped annual price increases: average of 5%, which is extremely rare for e-resources • About \$16.7 million total in CY17 • All available through the <i>very popular</i> CARLI Selection System

SHARED INSTITUTIONAL REPOSITORIES

Listening Sessions' Most Prevalent Topic:
The Need for Shared Institutional Repositories

CARLI Board has charged an IR Investigative Task Force to:

- Investigate feasibility of shared IR's and suitable platforms
- Conduct an environmental scan
- Assess members' existing repository structures and inventory
- Task force's charge dictates recommendation cannot impede CARLI core services and must include self-funded solution

What is an institutional repository?

Clifford Lynch, Executive Director, Coalition for Networked Information, stated

"In my view, a university-based institutional repository is a set of services that a university offers to the members of its community for the management and dissemination of digital materials created by the institution and its community members. It is most essentially an organizational commitment to the stewardship of these digital materials, including long-term preservation where appropriate, as well as organization and access or distribution."
