What is ILDS?

- ILDS is the Illinois Library Delivery Service.
- There are currently 141 delivery locations that comprise:
 - The Illinois Academic Community
 - Two regional library system service centers
 - The Chicago Public Library (Harold Washington Library)
- The service provides pickup and delivery, 5 days per week with 24-hour dock to dock service between ILDS direct delivery locations.
