Library patrons initiated 231.379 searches and downloaded 13,308 full-text articles in EBSCO Academic Search Complete at no direct cost to the libraries



3,341 library items were en route via **ILDS** from 118 source libraries to 137 destination libraries





Patrons at I-Share libraries checked out 8,643 items

3,089 unique new titles were added to the I-Share Union Catalog
