


Resource Sharing – New Layout for Borrowing Requests

 - Status and assignee information as facets









Import profiles: Skip validation issues


- Don't force manual handling
- Skipped records found in job report



Resource Management – Material Types


Physical Material Types

- Config > Resources > General > Physical Material Type Descriptions
- Fixed size list of codes (ExL) and descriptions (institutions) applied to items
- Size of list increased from 107(-ish) to 127
- 15 generic types customizable to any local definition



Electronic Resources

CZUTL updates include collection level management



Electronic Resources

- Alma's Overlap Analysis Tool now supports physical titles as well as electronic titles
- This allows you to load a list of titles and check if they exist in your physical or electronic inventory

Acquisitions – Editable lines in closed invoices

Selected fields within lines of closed invoices may now be edited.

- Handle data corrections from errors or migration surprises (especially subscriptions)
- Allows you to make invoice lines more identifiable
 - Subscription dates range
 - Additional information
 - Subscription date overlap
 - Price note
 - Note
 - Reporting Codes 1-5
- Enable/disable in Configuration
 - Configuration > Acquisitions > General > Other Settings: allow_edit_closed_invoice_line

Analytics – New Interface Rollout

New Analytics interface rollout began in February 2023.

- "New" = *analytics-in-the-Alma-UI* for users, not designers
- Largely associated with widgets, scheduled reports, and dashboards delivered to users
- Updated schedule
 - May: new interface is optional, per user details menu > feature rollout configuration
 - August: new interface becomes institution default; may display old via user details menu
 - November: new interface becomes standard; old version is retired
- Known issues with scheduling reports between old and new interfaces

This is not a change to the Analytics interface for designing reports.

Primo VE May 2023 Release Highlights

- Improved timeout experience
 - User receives 60 seconds warning before timeout with option to extend their session.
- Exact phrase searching
 - New "Equals exact phrase" option in Advanced Search for the Author, Title, or Subject.
- Resource type filter bar
 - New option under the basic search box allows users to narrow their search results by resource types
- Filter fines by type on My Library Card
 - New Fine Type filter in My Library Card to filter fines based on fine types: Active, All, Closed, In Dispute, and Transferred.

Primo VE – Improved Timeout Experience

- All of these are disabled by default; must be enabled
 - Find under: Configuration > Discovery > Authentication > User Authentication > Authentication settings at bottom of page

Primo VE – Timeout Experience options

- Extend the session
 - User receives message 60 seconds before timeout, and it will allow them to extend the session for another session period.
- Extend the session to maximum
 - Timeout message, PLUS allows user to extend session to the maximum period of 7 days (this maximum not configurable).
 - This setting takes precedence if both "Extend the session" and "Extend the session to maximum" options are enabled.
- User setting for extending the session
 - Adds the **Automatically extend my session** option to the My Library Card > Personal Details and Settings tab.
 - To enable, the **display_user_settings** parameter must also be set to **true** in the Discovery Customer Settings mapping table (Configuration > Discovery > Other > Customer Settings).

Primo VE – Exact Phrase Searching

Advanced Search option changes:

- Previously, the "Is (Exact)" option for Author, Title, and Subject field searches returned results that included the exact phrase but might also contain other words.
- NEW: Name of the "Is (Exact)" option changed to "Contains exact phrase." Behavior is the same.
- NEW: Users can now also choose a new "**Equals exact phrase**" option that returns results in which the specified Author, Title, or Subject field contains **only** the exact phrase.


Primo VE – Enabling Exact Phrase Searching

Must enable the new "Equals exact phrase" option in Configuration > Discovery
 > Display Configuration > Configure Views > Choose View > Advanced Search
 tab > Search Operators section (bottom of page)



Primo VE – Resource Type Filter Bar


New filter bar option for Resource Types below the Simple Search Box

- Shown below with the new filter bar enabled and five resource types added.
 - The default search is for "All" resource types
- Allow user to pre-filter results by Resource Type
- Only the enabled resources (up to a maximum of 10 6 in the ribbon, then a More dropdown button) will appear for basic searches.
- Resource Types in the ribbon are not dependent on whether the search results contain items matching that resource type



Primo VE – Resource Type Filter Bar details


- Note: Due to variances in queries and indexing, results from selecting Facet resource types **may differ** from selecting the same type with the new Resource Type Filter Bar.
- Not on by default, must be enabled.
- Note: This new filter bar **cannot be enabled** when the Basic Search pre-filter for resource types or indexes is already enabled on the Advanced Search tab of the View configuration.



Primo VE – Resource Type Filter Bar configuration


To enable: Configuration > Discovery > Display Configuration > Configure Views > Choose View > Brief Results tab > Resource Types Filters Bar section (bottom of page)

• Check the box to Enable; Customize to edit Resource Types in the bar



Primo VE – Filter Fines by Type in My Library Card

- Allows user to filter fines based on the following fine types: Active, All, Closed, In Dispute, and Transferred.
 - The filter does not include all possible fine types, only those that are relevant to the user's current fines and fees.
 - If there are only active fines, the Fines Type filter does not appear.
 - This is available by default; no configuration required to enable.



Primo VE – Customization of Resource Type Mapping

Also in the May release:

- Customization of default system Resource Type definitions is now possible.
- Number of Local Resource Types increased to 50 (from 20).
- Any changes require a job to be run to recalculate the Resource Types of bibs.
- Please do not add Local Resource Types or customize the default system Resource Types until CARLI and the Discovery Primo VE Committee (DPVEC) have a chance to review this new information and make consortial recommendations. Thank you!
