Method(s) of Data Collection and Analysis	Data will be collected using descriptive transaction logs. Data will also be accessed via existing Institutional Research data.
Findings	When it is safe to return to campus, we hope to learn the value the library has in overall student success.
Use of Findings	We will use the findings to help ensure there is seamless cooperation and coordination between other student success departments and the Library to ensure our new majority students achieve their academic goals.
Next Steps and Other Results	When it is safe to return to campus to collect the data we will need, we will present our findings to institutional leadership. We will continue to help students navigate the college experience.
Additional Reflections	We were excited to run this research project, but since the campus has closed due to the pandemic, we have not been able to collect the data we would need to make additional reflections.
