## The Alma record numbering system

### Introduction

All Alma record numbers end with the four digit code of the institution.

In the examples below all records end with the code "0951".

Each record also starts with a two digit code which is indicative of the record type.

In the examples below we will see the following two digit prefixes and record types:

- 99: Bibliographic records
- 22: Holding records
- 23: Items
- 11: Digital representation IED
- 12: Digital representation REP
- 13: Digital files
- 53: Portfolios
- 61: Packages







**One way to see it:**

All titles search > Click "View Digital Resource" (when there is a digital resource) >  
 Representation tab > Actions > View files > Actions > Deliver. Look at URL



**Another way to see it:**

Search for digital files > click edit > get to Digital File Resource Editor > go to summary tab > look at PID
