#### WHEN TO INPUT A NEW RECORD

- Before adding a new record search OCLC Connexion
  - To avoid duplicate records
  - To see if a record exists that may be upgraded or used to derive a new record.

# **OCLC ENCODING LEVELS (CHAPTER 2.4)**

- Full-level seeks to ensure inclusion of the essential data elements necessary to meet user needs. Full-level uses ELvl codes blank
- Minimal-level represents the minimum data necessary to identify an item.
   Minimal-level cataloging uses ELvl codes 7
- Abbreviated-level is a brief record that does not meet minimal-level cataloging specifications. Abbreviated-level uses ELvl codes 3

## HOW TO CREATE ORIGINAL RECORDS

- First step is to follow Jackie's search strategies to make sure there are no existing records to match the item you have in hand.
- Bibliographic Formats and Standards: <u>https://www.oclc.org/bibformats/en.html</u>
- From workform:
  - Setup to display RDA fields in workform: Tools > Options > RDA
  - Cataloging > Create > Single Record; choose format and workform type
  - Apply Constant Data Edit > Constant Data > Local > Apply from List

## **DERIVE FROM EXISTING RECORD**

- Derive from existing record:
  - Edit > Derive New Master Record
  - Setup for Derive Record: Tools > Options Derive records: select fields to transfer when using the derive command
  - When new record is completed, use Update or Produce command to add record to WorldCat: Action > Holdings > Update Holdings or Action > Holdings > Produce and Update Holdings
