

Data Migration Questionnaire Introduction: How to fill out this survey

The Data Migration Questionnaire (DMQ) is the first of 2 surveys the CARLI will ask you to complete to assist with your library's bibliographic data migration.

Please complete this DMQ by 9/20/17, CARLI staff will then reformat your answers and submit them to Ex Libris by 9/22/17 as indicated on the project timeline. Please Note: This will be the first draft, changes can be submitted, and final DMQ answers are due by 10/11/17, for reformatting and submission to Ex Libris by the timeline deadline of 10/13/17.

These questions assume you or your vendor are supplying your library's <u>bibliographic data</u> in MARC format with item level fields appended to the MARC bibliographic record, one field per item. This survey focuses on other data that does not have an industry standard format, including item record data such as copy number, call number, status information, etc.

It is important to note that generally speaking, the fields used in data extraction and migration are not the same fields used day-to-day in your current system. Your current vendor should be able to tell you how your data will be formatted in the files you provide to CARLI.

For each of the questions, we provide 2 or 3 examples of how your data might be formatted:

- some examples may apply if you are already using and sending us MFHDs (8xx fields),
- some examples may apply if your data will be in a local use field (9xx fields),
- some examples apply if you are sending us a delimited file (field_N) where the data fields within a record are separated by a delimiter.
