007	Physical description fixed field	Coded, copy-specific physical characteristics of the bibliographic item for which the holdings are recorded.
008	Fixed-length data elements	Thirty-two character positions containing data elements that provide coded information about the record.
014 \$a	Linkage number of Voyager “bound-withs”	A control number that shows the linkage between the holdings record and the bibliographic record; does NOT perform the linking function
014 \$9	Linkage number from migration	
852	<i>Location</i>	<i>Identifies the organization holding the item or from which it is available. May also contain detailed information about how to locate the item in a collection (e.g., the call number.</i>

These fields work in conjunction with the 863-865 fields.</i>	<i>Contain subfields that represent specific captions that are used with materials, such as “volumes”, “numbers”, “parts”, etc. and their foreign language equivalents. Directly relate to the enumeration and chronology data found in the 863-865 fields.</i>

863-865	<i>Enumeration and Chronology DATA fields. These fields work in conjunction with the 853-855 fields.</i>	<i>Contain subfields that represent the enumeration and/or chronology data related to the specific captions and patterns found in the 853-855 fields.</i>

864	Enumeration and chronology – Supplementary material	\$8 (linking #.seq #), \$a-\$c (enum), \$i-\$k (chron)

866-868	<i>Textual Holdings statement fields</i>	<i>Contain both the caption and the enumeration and/or chronology data. (They are not parsed separately as they are in the 853/863 pairs.)</i>
