I-Share Resource Sharing Code revised

- Eliminates Voyager-specific language
- Removes text specific to no-longer-supported ILLINET direct borrowing
- Specifies that the patron's library is responsible for covering costs of any direct shipping of materials directly to patrons
- Clarifies that I-Share libraries with collections outside Illinois are not required to make those available via I-Share requests
- Requires I-Share libraries to post their building access policies and hours on their websites
- Reminds I-Share libraries to keep their patron data as current as possible

Primo VE Configuration Options

Ranking Configuration

- Allows you to configure aspects of the results ranking algorithm to affect the order of <u>local</u> records in all search results
- Alma Configuration > Discovery > Search Configuration > Ranking Configuration
- Options include:
 - Field Boosting not recommended to alter unless specific local need
 - Date Boosting may choose to boost more recent materials
 - Resource Type Boosting may choose to boost some types
 - Institution Boosting boost your institution's records in search results that include the entire network

Boosting Records in Blended Search Profiles

- Alma Configuration > Discovery > Search Configuration > Search Profiles > Search Profiles tab
- If the "Search Type" is listed as Blended, you may boost or deboost results from one source over another.
- The most common scenarios for a Blended search are Search Profiles that include:
 - Local data and Central Index (CDI)
 - Local data, NZ (network) data, and Central Index (CDI)
- The default Search Profile "MyInst_and_CI" used by many libraries already boosts Local data over the Central Index data, but you may wish to boost it further.

Dedup and FRBR Options

- By default, Primo VE performs deduplication and FRBR-ization and groups records together when displaying search results.
- Records that have been deduplicated and grouped will not be obvious in search results.
 - Can use "<u>Dedup and FRBR Test Utility</u>" to reveal them
- Records in a FRBR group will appear with the indication "N
 versions found. See all versions >" as a single entry in the initial
 search results.
- Alma Configuration > Discovery > Display Configuration > Configure Views > Edit the View* > Brief Results tab

^{*}Settings are per View, so you can use a Test View for testing changes.

Dedup and FRBR Recommendations

- CARLI Recommendations
 - Sort FRBR Version list by: Date newest
 - Define FRBR display for local records: Generic
 - Enable FRBR checked
 - Enable Dedup checked

Best Practices for Testing Configuration Changes

Before you start:

- Identify several example Primo VE searches to serve as your baseline.
 Document the behavior of the example searches by copying search URLs, taking screenshots, or recording video.
- Reach out at your institution to other stakeholders.

When testing:

- Test one small change at a time.
- After you make a change, use a new Private browser window to perform the search again in order to avoid caching.
- Document what you change as you go, noting the effects on examples.
- Consider small group testing with other stakeholders at your institution.

Once you've decided to implement a change in production:

- Document the change, the date, and the rationale for the change.
- Share information on the change(s) with other stakeholders.

What is Primo VE CDI?

- Central Discovery Index (CDI): a database of citations collected from e-resources including journal articles, e-books, legal documents and more.
- Used in Primo VE "Everything" and "Articles" type search slots. Note: A **Discovery** or indexing feature (not **Delivery**/Get Full Text per se.)

Sources of CDI Citations: From Ex Libris Alma harvesting, From your IZ and the NZ

Publisher and aggregator content

E E.g.: Springer, Wiley, ProQuest

Digital repositories



E.g.: Esploro, Fedora, Dspace

CDI Settings for Institution Zone e-collections: What are they?

- 1. Activation options Alma e-collection activation- yes or no
- 2. Only Some Titles active? Selective yes or no
- 3. Suppress sending citations to CDI setting
- 4. Only send citations to CDI option (no full text)


1. I-Share is Alma "Easy Active" activation

If active, e-collection sends to CDI with some exceptions: EBSCOhost & a few other vendors.


These settings are in the CDI search activation tab.

2. CDI Only Some Titles active? (Selective setting)

- Recommend set to "Yes" = selective for all package e-collections even aggregators/100%ers
- Why change? To improve delivery of Full text.
- NOT the setting "Activate new portfolios associated with service automatically?":

CDI Only Some Titles active: "Yes" = selective even if an aggregator. What search behavior is changed? Here is an example where it was set to "No":

The "View Online" link on full display to a Gale collection didn't connect. That title wasn't in the e-collection yet. If it had been set at selective= yes, less chance of this happening.




3. CDI Suppress sending citations to CDI setting-"Do not show as Full Text Available in CDI even if active in Alma."

- Why change?
- To declutter search results by reducing very similar citations going into CDI.
- Less exact duplicates in search results.
- Must rely on CDI citation sources you can't turn off.



Duplicates in brief results







4. "CDI Only Full Text activation"

- Means send citations to CDI only. Don't use portfolios in ranking results.
 - Have to use for database e-collections.
 - Why change if a full text package or aggregator? Library doesn't get the full text but want to use the indexing/citations.
 - What search behavior is changed? (after the overnight CDI jobs)
 - Get more citations and better-quality ones (potentially) but more chance of no full text to link to and more ILL requests.



Ex Libris new and revised documentation on CDI

Note: All I-Share Libraries are Easy Active for CDI and always have been. Ignore any text only about "Fully Flexible" options.

CARLI CDI Testing Example Recording sheet

- To Edit CDI settings, need roles:
 - CDI Inventory Operator
 - Electronic Inventory Operator
- Be Consistent: Use the same web browser, internet service provider, and also use private or incognito windows to minimize effects of caching data.
- Timing: Changes to CDI settings take 48 to 72 hours to be reflected in Primo VE.
