I-Share libraries need to reduce our total number of Bibliographic Titles

- Ex Libris' Alma pricing is based on
 - Bibliographic title count
 - E-journal count
 - Alma "Named Users"
- "Bibliographic Titles" includes:
 - Bibliographic records in an institution zone
 - Bibliographic records in the network zone
 - Authority records in either IZ or NZ
- This count is reduced by the number of records that represent electronic journals

- CARLI's *consortial* Alma contract allows for
 - 46,420,000 active Bibliographic Titles
 - We currently have more (counts changing daily)
 - We need to reduce this number and provide room for growth.
- There are not specific title limits for each I-Share library
 - Our contract is for the consortium as a whole,
 - Ex Libris provides neither the price nor the pricing metrics library by library


- CARLI has contracted with IHLS to hire contract catalogers to help complete this work
 - CARLI will be training these catalogers and they will be doing a lot of the work to clean up several categories of duplicate and/or excess records

Reduce Duplication of Records

- Remove Bibs with no Holdings (IZ and NZ)
- Deduplicate Bibs
- Manage Certain Electronic Resource Collections in the Network Zone
 - Open Access/Free Collections – Should be active only in Network Zone.
 - NZ is designed to manage these collections centrally to benefit all consortial members. Optimizes record and data sharing.

- Reducing duplication engages efficiencies to managing and sharing resources
 - Whenever possible, share electronic collection data once for all members.
 - Deduplicating bibs improves imports and syncs with OCLC
 - Fewer records = cleaner catalogs
- This is the work we should be doing at this stage of our Alma implementation.

- Named Users Count already reduced: 3,117
 - “CARLI_” staff users have been deactivated by CARLI, CARLI will use one generic user in each IZ.
 - Several institutions have created shared circ users
- IHLS CMC staff will have named users active while working in an IZ
- Libraries/CARLI should target test accounts
