- Named Users Count as of October 12: 3,584
 - Includes 534 new, temporary users for IHLS CMC staff; without those: total is 3,050 - down from 3,117 on Sept. 9
 - “CARLI_” staff users have been deactivated by CARLI,
 - CARLI has started using one generic user in each IZ.
 - Several institutions have created shared circ users
- Names User Count goal in our contract: 2,162
- Libraries/CARLI should target test accounts
- Deadline to review your Named Users is December 1

I-Share libraries need to reduce our total number of Bibliographic Titles

- Ex Libris' Alma pricing is based on
 - Bibliographic title count
 - E-journal count
 - Alma "Named Users"
- "Bibliographic Titles" includes:
 - Bibliographic records in an institution zone
 - Bibliographic records in the network zone
 - Authority records in either IZ or NZ
- This count is reduced by the number of records that represent electronic journals

- CARLI's *consortial* Alma contract allows for
 - 46,420,000 active Bibliographic Titles
 - We currently have more (counts changing daily)
 - We need to reduce this number and provide room for growth.
- There are not specific title limits for each I-Share library
 - Our contract is for the consortium as a whole,
 - Ex Libris provides neither the price nor the pricing metrics library by library

- Reducing duplication engages efficiencies to managing and sharing resources
 - Whenever possible, share electronic collection data once for all members.
 - Deduplicating bibs improves imports and syncs with OCLC
 - Fewer records = cleaner catalogs
- This is the work we should be doing at this stage of our Alma implementation.

- Goals:
 - Manage Electronic Resource Collections in the Network Zone when possible
 - Delete bib records with no Inventory
 - Eliminate duplicate bib records

- Open Access/Free Collections should be active only in Network Zone
- NZ is designed to manage these collections centrally to benefit all consortial members. Optimizes record and data sharing.

- Work is almost complete! Collectively, we have already deleted over 850,000 titles!

- E-Collections funded by CARLI are being handled in separate phases for NZ management as described in [our communications](#). Future phases coming soon.

- First phase of CARLI fully funded e-colls includes:
 - Harper's Weekly, 1857-1912
 - Historical Statistics of the United States (from Cambridge University Press)
 - Sage E-Journal 2007 Deep Backfile
- I-Share institutions that elected to delete the duplicate e-collections should complete this work by October 15.
- CARLI staff work is in progress to delete these e-collections for institutions that requested it.

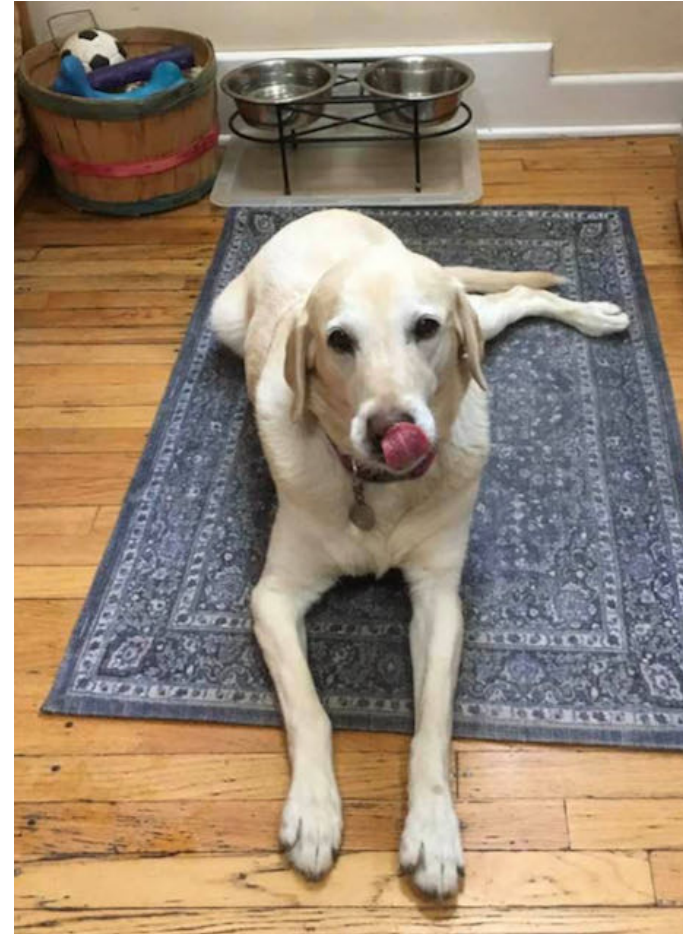
- Next phase: Remove Bibs with no Inventory (IZ and NZ)
- Announcement to Liaisons/Directors, reports of each IZ's records, and documentation will be posted soon.
- Numbers of bibs with no inventory in IZs varies from under 10 to over 300,000.
 - These reports exclude Bibs that are part of boundwith relationships
- Timeline:
 - By October 15 - Reports and documentation is shared
 - By October 22 - Let CARLI know if you will do the work in your IZ or would you like CARLI to do the work
 - By November 24 - Institutions must complete the work in their IZs

- Consultation Meetings are designed to discuss questions or concerns about your institution's data in relation to the title reduction project.
- If you are concerned about being able to accomplish the work, remember we have contracted with IHLS staff to help us with this project.
- Work will start as announced, even if your meeting is scheduled after the start date.
