

- Named Users Count as of November 18: 3,562
  - Includes 644, temporary users for IHLS CMC staff;
    - without those: total is 2,918
  - Several institutions making changes after Fall Semester
    - Expecting another decrease of 75-80 users; maybe more?
  - More institutions have created shared users
- Names User Count goal in our contract: 2,162
- Target test accounts (15), users that login infrequently
- Deadline to review your Named Users is December 1

#### **Alma Title Count Reduction Project**

- Goals:
  - Manage Electronic Resource Collections in the Network Zone when possible
  - Delete bib records with no Inventory
  - Eliminate duplicate bib records

# Open Access/Free Collections should be active only in Network Zone

- NZ enables sharing to all consortial members
  - Optimizes record, data sharing, and data correction
  - Sub-Project page: <a href="https://www.carli.illinois.edu/products-services/i-share/title-count-reduction/open-access-e-collections">https://www.carli.illinois.edu/products-services/i-share/title-count-reduction/open-access-e-collections</a>
- Work is complete in all IZs!
- What about new stuff?

E-Collections fully or partially funded by CARLI are being handled in separate phases for NZ management:

- First round of <u>CARLI fully funded e-colls</u> is complete:
  - Harper's Weekly, 1857-1912
  - Historical Statistics of the United States (from Cambridge University Press)
  - Sage E-Journal 2007 Deep Backfile
- Second round—<u>removing E-Collections no longer</u> <u>funded by CARLI that were not continued by libraries</u> is in progress
  - Black Thought and Culture
  - Women and Social Movements in the United States, 1600-200
- Next round: Alexander Street Press e-collections





#### Removing Bibs with no Inventory from IZs

- Announcement to Liaisons/Directors, reports of each IZ's records, and documentation has been posted.
  - These reports exclude Bibs that are part of boundwith relationships
- Institutions that elected to complete the work on their own should do so by November 24.

#### Removing Bibs with no Inventory from the NZ

 IHLS Alma Cleanup Team began deleting records on Oct. 14






#### TITLE REDUCTION PROJECT STATISTICS

#### As of November 16:

- E-Resource bibs deleted: 2,161,417
- Total bibs deleted: 4,278,348
  - Includes bibs with no inventory (IZ & NZ) and e-collections
- Consortial title count: 71,725,481
  - Target is 46,420,000





# Related Records in Alma



#### What are Related Records in Alma?


- Bibliographic records can be related and linked together by MARC 76X, 77X, 78X, and 8XX fields
- Some of the most common fields are 773, 774, 776, 780, 785, and 830
- When any of these fields in a bib record in Alma refer to another bib record within Alma, a related record relationship is established by the system.






# Related Record relationships display in Alma search results in two ways:

1. Other details tab > Related Records indicator






2. Physical inventory tab > Related Records column AND Other details > Related Records -- only when 774, 786, 800, 810, 811, or 830 fields establish relationship





Note: The presence of the Physical inventory tab > Related Records column with




means that the holdings are not attached to bib record that you are viewing; they are attached to another related bibliographic record.





# **Viewing Related Records**

- To see which other bib records in Alma are related, click the hotlinked number in the "Other details" tab after "Related Records"
- You can also click the "Holdings Of Related Records" or "Items of Related Records" links to see more about those records.





### Why discuss Related Records in Alma?

- As part of the Title Reduction Count Project, CARLI has asked I-Share libraries to delete bibliographic records in your IZ with no holdings.
- Some of the bibs without holdings may have Related Records.
- If using the "Delete Bibliographic Records" job, CARLI recommends using the option to "Do not delete if related to other record"

### **Evaluating Related Records**

- Example 1 Microform record in JUD IZ
- Example 2 E-book record in PRC IZ
- "Check the shelf" to see if your library has a physical item and if so, add holdings.
- The Related Records indicators may not tell the whole story. Search in Alma for "duplicate" records (title or control numbers) that may not display as Related Records.
- If you do not have any inventory that should be on this bib, delete the bib from the IZ.






### Reports of Bib Records With No Inventory

- CARLI provided I-Share libraries with reports of records in your IZs as of Sept. 29 in Box: XXX\_Bibliographic\_records\_in\_Institution\_with\_no\_inventory\_#.xlsx
  - These reports had Bound Withs REMOVED from them.
- Libraries can run the shared "Bibliographic Records with No Inventory" report in Analytics, but it will contain Bound Withs in the results.

#### **Bound Withs**

- Bound Withs are Related Records but do NOT need to be cleaned up as part of the Title Count Reduction Project
  - They were removed from the CARLI-provided reports
  - Bound With relationships legitimately have full bib records without any holdings attached in Alma and those bibs should not be deleted.
- CARLI's <u>Bound With Practices</u> webpage has recommendations for Bound Withs in Alma, including options for enhancing records that were migrated from Voyager, if you are interested.
