Finding items that haven't circulated

- Common report request for libraries planning (or being told) to weed.
- Sometimes limited by collection or call number range

Query Strategy

- Find current and historical transactions from time on Voyager
- Find items not listed among those transactions

Access Resources

- CIRC_TRANSACTIONS
- CIRC_TRANS_ARCHIVE
- Circulation Transactions (Charges) query
- Any shelf list query including ITEM_ID

Query Techniques

- Union query
- Outer joins
- Join on “Is Null”

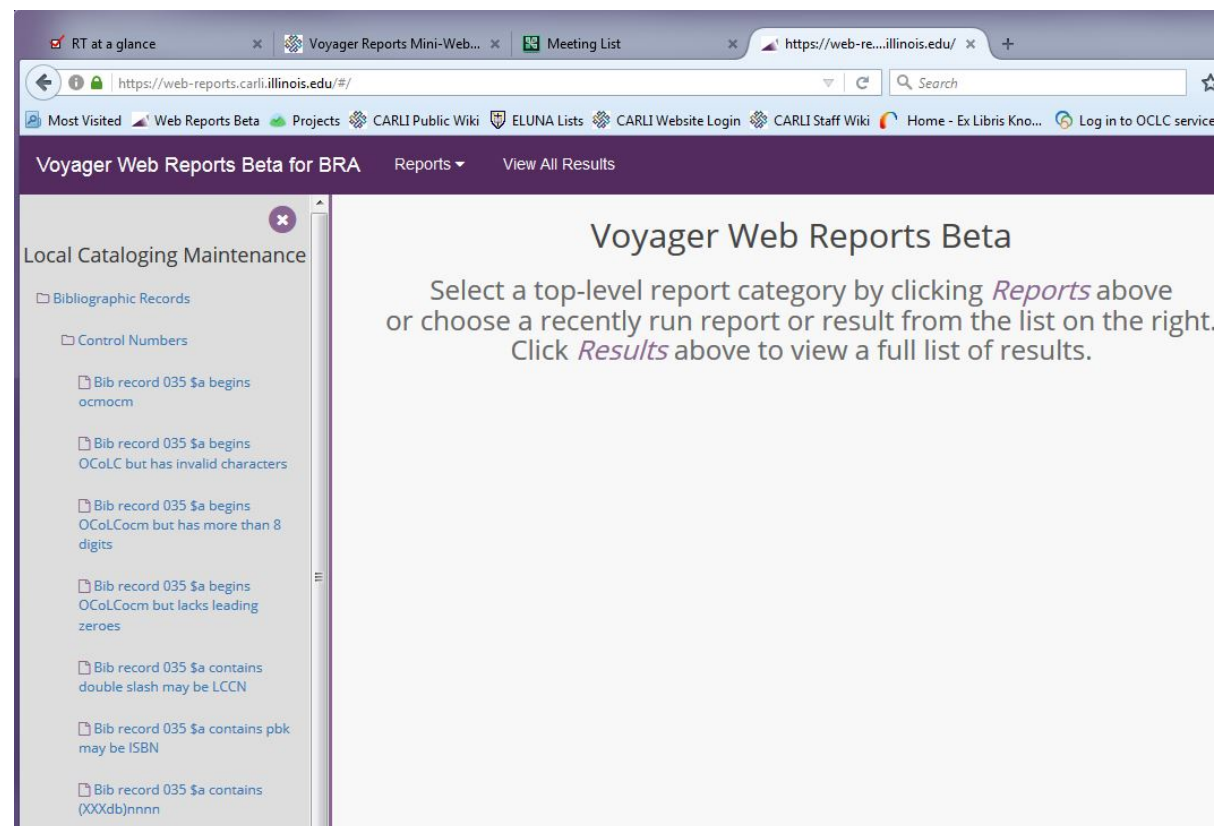

- Resolve these issues to reduce duplication in union catalog and to prevent duplication locally
