

Make Table Queries

- What it does:
 - Select data
 - Output to table
- How to use:
 - Create a normal select query
 - Make sure it captures the data you need*
 - Change the Query Type to Make Table
 - Name the output table
 - Run! the query with "!" button
 - Save your query with a similar name

* This may or may not be the data you need for the whole query; maybe just enough to save you some work later.

Reasons for Make-Table Queries

- Data snapshot
 - Save values that exist now
 - Append later for comparison
 - E.g., Usage via item or patron counters
 - Create a static set for long term analysis
- Reducing processing overhead
 - Make data local instead of remote
 - Work with pre-selected lists
 - Work with pre-processed blob data¹

- Compartmentalize use of the same table
 - Establish a list on a base condition
 - Find related values for the same record²
 - E.g., Record contains more than one _____

Drawbacks

- Static data ages
- If keeping older data
 - Change query type to append
 - Rename older table with a date
- Capture what you need static up front


- 1. E.g., Bibs_w_590; Bib Records without LC Class in 050 or 090
- 2. E.g., Bib record 035 \$a contains second OCLC number; and, Bibliographic records with multiple 245 fields.

Options for finding URLs

- Blob function for Bib 856 (slow)
- Blob function for MFHD 856 (slow)
- ELINK_INDEX table (fast!)
 - Each URL found in a record*
 - In any type of record (bib, mfhd, auth, and e-item)
 - Link and "link text"

Before using ELINK_INDEX

- Making the correct joins
- Criteria on the correct fields



* ELINK_INDEX includes URLs found in bib 856\$u and mfhd 856\$u, as well as the following fields: bib 505\$u, bib 506\$u, bib 514\$u, bib 520\$u, bib 530\$u, bib 540\$u, bib 545\$u, bib 552\$u, bib 583\$u, bib 856\$g, mfhd 563\$u, mfhd583\$u.

Improving on ELINK_INDEX

- Elink_Bibs & Elink_Mfhds queries
 - Preset record_type for B or M
 - Alias record_id as bib_id or mfhd_id for easy join
 - Includes join to ELINK_RECORD_TYPE
- Join these into deeper subqueries
 - Bibs with urls in 856\$u
 - Eresource mfhds without urls!
