What Is It?

ProQuest 360 Core is the old Serials Solutions. Serials Solutions is:

- A management tool for electronic subscriptions, including databases and eBook collections.
- Provides search capabilities to locate full text journals within your database collections and point the user to the specific database where the full text journal is found.
- Provides searchable subject lists that show users how many journals within a subject are available to the library full text.
- Journals can be searched by title, title words, or ISSN.
- Subject lists can be created using either HILCC or MeSH hierarchical terminology.
- Libraries use Serials Solutions to identify subscribed databases, but a library can also create a unique database for single journals or e-resources.
- The web page interface can be branded by each library.
- The system provides an overlap analysis service and use statistics through ProQuest's Intota Assessment system.

How Might It Relate to SFX?

ProQuest 360 Core uses a knowledge base of journal and database holdings. Data can be transferred out of 360 Core using the Data Management page and the download feature. Data can then be saved to an Excel spreadsheet. Similarly, data can also be uploaded back into the Data Management system. Similar data can be uploaded and downloaded using the SFX Dataloader.

Are There Pros and Cons for Integrating SFX with 360 Core?

Pros

- ProQuest 360 Core provides subject access using HILCC or MeSH hierarchy.
- Patrons to see all full text journals in a given subject.
- Patrons can search for a specific journal and see full-text coverage.
- Title lists under these subjects are useful for collection development and new-program analysis.
- Libraries can create their own databases in ProQuest 360 Core.
- Libraries can create a special list of e-resources from your catalog or a list of dissertations.
- Print collections can also be added.

Cons

- Changes to data in ProQuest 360 Core are run overnight, unlike SFX, which processes changes automatically. Updates take some time to show.
- It can also take some time for ProQuest to trouble-shoot problems with serials titles. For example, a question about coverage dates is still open for our library over 3 weeks after the initial contact.
